<p>What is membership</p>	<p>Membership is being a part of the planning, organising, decision making, safety, maintaining our site and fundraising.</p> <p>A happy, co-operative, interested and committed group of members will help the gardens thrive.</p>
<p>When does the membership year begin and end.</p>	<p>Currently the membership year runs from 1st September to 30th August.</p>
<p>Who can be a member</p>	<p>Any individual or family/group can apply to become a member</p>
<p>How do you become a member and how much does it cost</p>	<p>To become a member you must complete an application form. These are available by emailing woopigardens@gmail.com and requesting a form.</p> <p>Membership fees :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individual \$10 (\$5 concession) • Family \$ 15 (\$10 concession) <p>Membership fees must be paid in full no matter what part of the membership year remains.</p>
<p>How do you stay a member</p>	<p>To remain a member you must :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • stick to all our garden rules • pay the annual membership fee each year before 1st September each year • actively participate in at least 2 working bees each year (or see the committee about volunteering in other ways)
<p>What do members get</p>	<p>Members can :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • apply for a private plot (when they become available) • have a say in the future of the garden • receive updates about the garden and activities • Voting rights at general and AGM meetings <p>NB: 'Active volunteers' can also share in the produce from the community beds</p>
