What is membership	Membership is being a part of the planning, organising, decision making, safety, maintaining our site and fundraising.

When does the membership year begin and end.	Currently the membership year runs from 1st September to 30th August.
Who can be a member	Any individual or family/group can apply to become a member
How do you become a member and how much does it cost	 To become a member you must complete an application form. These are available by emailing woopigardens@gmail.com and requesting a form. Membership fees : Individual \$10 (\$5 concession) Family \$15 (\$10 concession) Membership fees must be paid in full no matter what part of the membership year remains.
How do you stay a member	 To remain a member you must : stick to all our garden rules pay the annual membership fee each year before 1st September each year actively participate in at least 2 working bees each year (or see the committee about volunteering in other ways)
What do members get	 Members can : apply for a private plot (when they become available) have a say in the future of the garden receive updates about the garden and activities Voting rights at general and AGM meetings NB: 'Active volunteers' can also share in the produce from the community beds
